Ebola and Infectious Disease Control May Depend On Specialized Prescription Eyewear

A "Spectacle kit" is a combination of corrective lenses and frame that fit inside safety goggles, full-face masks and self-contained breathing apparatus (SCUBA). The optical properties of prescription lenses inside full face masks and goggles changes the corrective ability of Rx lenses due to the distance these devices sit away from the eye. Those distances must be calculated into the prescription to provide the proper visual acuity, which may be different from a regular prescription glasses. In the medical community, these masks, goggles and SCBA's are of particular importance in treating and maintaining infectious disease control including EBOLA and can impact the accuracy in which patients are treated.

Typically, healthcare workers caring for EBOLA and other patients with highly contagious diseases, who must wear glasses to perform their jobs, often have a dilemma. Many times their glasses frames may not fit within the confines of the protective safety mask, or goggles they must wear. This causes discomfort, potential physical breaches in the workers' protective gear and may increase the vulnerability of exposure. Certain lines of Industrial Vision Corp spectacle kits are designed to fit inside these highly protective masks and goggles providing superior vision support to the worker while maintaining a safe, impermeable barrier.
